- Understanding the importance of the individual's rights in the safeguarding context, including Making Safeguarding Personal.
- An exploration of the local multi-agency safeguarding adults arrangements and procedures and the [London MA Safeguarding Adults Policy and Procedures](#).
- The roles and responsibilities of different professionals and agencies in referrals, and undertaking a safeguarding enquiry.
