Objectives

By the end of the session participants will have:

a general understanding of the terms self-neglect and hoarding and be familiar with the [Redbridge Multi-Agency Self-Neglect and Hoarding Protocol](#).

They will be aware of what the indicators are, how these can be of safeguarding concern and how to seek support for the individual and make a safeguarding referral as appropriate.

The course will include:

- An overview of self-neglect and indicators.
- The interface between self-neglect and safeguarding adults.
- An introduction to the complex issues surrounding self-neglect and hoarding, including mental capacity.
- An introduction to the Redbridge MA Self-Neglect and Hoarding Protocol.
- The roles of different professionals and agencies in responding
- What action to take if someone is considered to be at risk.
- Information on local, regional and national support groups.
