Objectives

By the end of the session participants will have:

A basic understanding of exploitation of adults at risks, the different types, risk factors and indicators. They will also know how make a referral.

The course will include:

- An explanation of exploitation and why it happens.
- An introduction to the different types of exploitation that can be experienced by adults at risk including Cuckooing, Hate Crime/Mate Crime, County Lines, Grooming and Organised Crime, Sexual Exploitation, Modern Slavery and Human trafficking.
- What makes some adults more vulnerable than others.
- Indicators and risk factors involved.
- The roles of different professionals and agencies in responding.
- What action to take if someone is considered to be at risk of exploitation.
