Background

The event will be led by [Karl Mason, Senior Lecturer in Social Work](#), researcher and writer on the topic. It is open to all professionals and volunteers working with adults at risk in Redbridge and is a Level 2 Training Event.

Learning Outcomes

The event will provide the following:

- an understanding of the background and legal context of Discriminatory Abuse of adults at risk;
- an understanding of the different types of Discriminatory Abuse and how this can be compounded by multiple intersecting characteristics and may feature alongside other forms of abuse e.g. neglect, organisational abuse etc.;
- understanding of the overlap with hate crime;
- information and support in relation to making a safeguarding adult referral where discriminatory or any other form of abuse is suspected;
- recognition of direct and indirect discriminatory practice by individuals and agencies and the PiPOT process; and
- consideration of barriers to identification and reporting and to improve confidence when working with discrimination.

As well as learning, the event will be an opportunity for networking, improving understanding of different roles and responsibilities in relation to safeguarding adults and each attendee will receive a resource pack to support dissemination of learning in the workplace.
