Redbridge Safeguarding Adults Board (RSAB) Safeguarding Adults Network Forum Terms of Reference (ToR)

Aims:

- To enable the contribution of a user perspective to the development of safeguarding adults work across Redbridge and influence change in policies, procedures and practice through the Safeguarding Adults Board.
- To support the development of safeguarding adults practice that is sensitive to the needs of adults at risk and their carers upholding the values of making safeguarding personal.
- To ensure that adults at risk of harm know where to go for help when they are being abused or at risk of being abused.
- To provide ideas about how to prevent people being abused or mistreated.
- To contribute to raising awareness of safeguarding adults amongst service user groups, in particular those most at risk of being abused or exploited.
- To contribute to reducing the risks of people being abused, exploited or neglected.

Membership:

- Service users or their carers/family with an interest in safeguarding adults issues.
- Representatives from community and voluntary groups that work with older people.
- Practitioner representative from the Borough's Safeguarding and Protection Team.
- Safeguarding Adult Board Manager.
